



EcoCarbon - Membership

The current uncertainty in climate change policy may well continue for some time. Now is the time to explore how new frameworks will emerge, take account of a range of views on abatement methodologies, and seek out appropriate risk management strategies for meeting the expectations of a future compliance regime.

The history of EcoCarbon, Inc (www.ecocarbon.org.au) as a national forum on climate change dates from 2000. It has built a strong reputation for encouraging informed debate and presenting a diverse range of views on domestic and international actions. We believe it is now time to reinvigorate the discussion and seek greater involvement across organisations so expertise does not become narrowly focused and specialised.

EcoCarbon is an independent think tank and does not take a position for or against specific policies or advocate strategies to Government – apart from a general belief in the use of market mechanisms as a cost effective method of achieving compliance at least cost. Taxation also needs to be considered as part of the market policy mix to place a price on carbon.

Benefits of membership
